

Prep Warrigal Road State School Curriculum Overview for Term 2, 2025

ENGLISH:

Reading and Viewing:

Students read, view and comprehend texts, making connections to personal experiences. They identify the language features of texts, including connections between print and images. Students will know and use the most common sounds (phonemes) represented by the letters. They will read words including consonant-vowel-consonant words and some high-frequency words.

Writing and Creating:

Students will create short written texts, using words and images where appropriate. They will report information and recall key ideas. Students will use words and phrases from learning and texts.

When writing, students will focus on:

- Forming letters correctly.
- Spelling most consonant-vowel-consonant words.
- Experimenting with capital letters and full stops.

Students will focus on

MATHEMATICS:

Number and Algebra:

- Partition and combine collections up to 10 in different ways, representing these with numbers.
- Represent practical situations that involve quantifying, equal sharing, adding to and taking away from collections to at least 10.

Measurement and Space:

• Sequence and connect familiar events to the time of day.
